Purpose of Job:

To undertake the cleaning of the School site to ensure the School is kept in a clean, safe and hygienic condition

Summary of Main Activities:

Maintain all internal areas to a high standard, free from litter and dirt, ensuring litter bins are emptied, cleaned and lined, all spillages mopped up, marks and scuffs on all surfaces removed, door mats lifted and shaken when required and any hazards treated or signed and reported.

Ensure all toilets are maintained in a hygienic condition throughout the school day, floors are damp mopped after break and lunch and when required outside of these times.

Ensure the areas of the school that you are designated to are always clean and fully presentable.

Operate machinery where appropriate to assist with cleaning duties including vacuum cleaners, scrubbers, buffers, jetters and steamers.

To carry out all duties with due regard for Health and Safety Regulations and adhere to the School's policies and team's values.
